Job Title: Clinical Scientist Developer

Duration: 12 months initially (supporting the externally funded Histopathology Project)

Hours: 14.8 (0.2)

Grade: Secondment of experienced NHS scientist

Reports to: Head of Department

Overview of Project: to use specialist expertise and technical knowledge to develop a series of on-line short courses for the upskilling of biomedical/clinical scientists working towards consultant clinical scientists, to allow smooth transition to, and successful completion of, the Higher Specialist Scientist Training (HSST) programme.

Working relationships: The post holder will work primarily with the Head of Department and the external partner on the project, the National School of Health Care Science. Engaging with other members of the University and external PSRBs as appropriate.

Principal Accountabilities: To develop a suite of non-credit bearing short self-study packages to meet the knowledge and skills requirements of histopathology and, where appropriate, other healthcare science disciplines, which can be delivered via the NSHCS training e-platform.

In particular, the Clinical Scientist Developer will:

- i. Work with external partners to review current gaps in up skilling;
- ii. Work with the HoD and external partners to review existing packages;
- iii. Planning of new on-line packages and ensuring they are fit for purpose;
- iv. Work flexibly and carry out other duties of an appropriate level as requested by the Head of Department.
